Professor Chao began his career in Toronto, Canada, but returned to Hong Kong, where he was born and raised, in the 1990s. He also spent over ten years in Beijing until 2015, where he experienced firsthand the significant growth and transformation in many sectors in mainland China. Professor Chao is a firm believer in actively working to make a positive impact on the people he works with and on society. He was awarded the China Women's Empowerment Principles Awards – Leadership Commitment by the United Nations Women in 2020.

Professor Chao is the Founding President of the Association of Hong Kong Accounting Advisors. The Association's purpose is to unite in purpose and strengthen our foundation to drive sustainable growth. His current and past external appointments included membership of The Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference (CPPCC); Election Committee, HKSAR; Exchange Fund Advisory Committee, Hong Kong Monetary Authority; Expert Advisor in accounting to the Ministry of Finance; Honorary President, Shanghai Hong Kong Association and Honorary Vice President, Hong Kong Fujian Association; Honorary Advisor, Federation of Hong Kong Shanghai Associations; Chairman, Advisory Board, Mile Green Co., Ltd. and Adjunct Professor, Hong Kong Polytechnic University. Professor Chao is a Chartered Professional Accountant in Canada and a Certified Public Accountant in Hong Kong.



Mr Clement Cheung, GBS, JP

Chief Executive Officer of the Insurance Authority

Mr Cheung has been the Chief Executive Officer of the Insurance Authority since 15 August 2018. He joined the Administrative Service in 1983 and was involved in the formulation and implementation of various government policies. Key positions held by Mr Cheung have included Director of the Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office in Singapore from 1998 to 2001, taking charge of ASEAN affairs and coping with the impact of the Asian Financial Crisis; Commissioner of Insurance from 2006 to 2009, responsible for prudential regulation of authorized insurers during the global financial crisis; Postmaster General from 2009 to 2011, making notable achievements in corporate structuring and business development; Commissioner of Customs and Excise in September 2011, combatting smuggling activities, interdicting drug trafficking, protecting intellectual property rights and safeguarding consumer interests. He became Secretary for the Civil Service in July 2015 before proceeding on retirement in July 2017.

Crown is also a leader in the field of household removals as well as information and document management with over forty-three million cartons of business documents managed from its worldwide facilities. The Group provides specialized packing and storage of fine arts and provides storage of fine wines and

has built a large number of warehouse facilities around the world.

Mr Thompson serves as Chairman or as a Board member of numerous charitable organizations. His particular interests are charities related to children, cancer, education and art. He is the Chairman of the Asian Youth Orchestra and The Honorary President of the Society for the Promotion of Hospice Care. He has been mentoring university students in Hong Kong for over twenty years.

Mr Thompson was awarded the Gold Bauhinia Star, Hong Kong's second highest award, by the Hong Kong Government in 2003. He received the Honorary Doctorate in Business Administration from the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology as well as an Honorary Doctorate of Humane Letters from his alma mater, San Jose State University in California. He also received the DHL/SCMP Lifetime Achievement Award in 2014 as well as many other honours.

Mr Wilfred Yiu

Wilfred Yiu was formerly Deputy Chief Executive Officer of Hong Kong Exchanges and Clearing Limited (HKEX). He served at the exchange from April 2019 to December 2024.

In addition to this role, Mr Yiu acted as Co-Chief Operating Officer and Co-Head of Markets, with oversight of HKEX's Markets and IT divisions. He was also Chief Executive of HKEX's wholly-owned subsidiaries, The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited and Hong Kong Futures Exchange Limited.

Mr Yiu joined HKEX in 2019 as Head of Markets and was named Co-Chief Operating Officer in 2023. Since joining the Group, he played a leading role in strengthening HKEX's market infrastructure and diversifying its product and service ecosystem. He oversaw the launch of major initiatives including significant expansion to the Connect Programme, enhancement of Hong Kong's Role as Asia's ETF marketplace, the rollout of Severe Weather Trading arrangements for Hong Kong market, HKD-RMB Dual Counter Model and Derivatives Holiday Trading, providing investors with greater opportunities and wider cross-border market accessibility.

Mr Yiu has 30 years of experience in international capital markets and has worked at global banks in the US, Mainland China, and Hong Kong. Prior to joining HKEX, he had a 19-year career with Goldman Sachs, where he was last Deputy Chief Executive Officer and Chief Operating Officer at Beijing Gao Hua Securities Company, a joint venture of Goldman Sachs in Mainland China, and was responsible for the company's China sales and trading businesses. Previously, Mr Yiu was Head of Credit Structured Products for Asia at Goldman Sachs in Hong Kong.

Mr Yiu was a member of the Supervisory Committee for the Tracker Fund of Hong Kong and a member of the Advisory Committee for the Securities and Futures Commission.
